

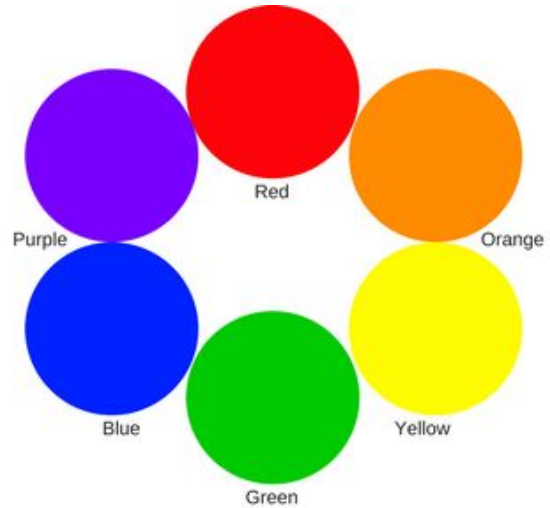
Project #4: Found Object Color Wheel

Hello LCS students and families!

This is your final Art project for the 2019-2020 school year! **It is due in one week: Wednesday, May 27.**

In the art room, I would often talk about the **Color Wheel**.

Here is a simple color wheel with only Primary and Secondary colors.



Primary Colors are red, blue, and yellow.

Secondary Colors are orange, green, and violet (purple).

The final project is to make a Found Object Color Wheel. Found Objects are things around your house that are mainly one color. You want to find 3-5 objects of each color and arrange them in rainbow order.

Steps:

1. Find 3-5 objects of these colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet (purple)
2. Arrange them as the video shows in rainbow/color wheel order (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet (purple))

4. Be sure to put away the objects you used when you are finished :)
